TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** pink-red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** striking, large, cones | **Fruit colour:** yellow-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** red-brown
