USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5)

Flowers: raceme, pendulous, big | **Flower colour:** red-violet | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, big, opposite, lacinate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, scarlet | **Fruits:** striking, winged, capsules | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow
