Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, climate trees | **Topiary on stem:** globe, pyramid, cone | **Topiary:** globe

USE

Location: square, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: umbels, corymbose, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, opposite, polished, dentate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, winged | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** corky | **Root system:** many hair roots, central root
