USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 14 - 20 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.6 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** variegated yellow, buds yellow, variegated pink, Variegated leaf | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, opposite, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, winged | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** grey-green | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, extensive, highly branched
