USE

Location: in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark red, buds red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, dissected, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** discrete, winged, small | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots
