### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 7 m | **Width:** 6 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** corymbose, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** buds red, red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, leathery, dissected, serrate, curly | **Autumn colour:** scarlet, red-violet | **Fruits:** discrete, winged | **Fruit colour:** red-violet | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-violet | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots
