**Tree types:** standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** pyramid, cone, multi-stem umbrella, espalier, pleached

### USE

**Location:** avenue, car park / parking lot, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

**Flowers:** raceme, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, opposite, leathery, polished, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange, dark red | **Fruits:** striking, winged, raceme | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots, central root, roots push up surface
