Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, opposite, hairy, serrate, ternate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red | **Fruits:** winged, capsules | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** cinnamon-brown, grey | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed, corky | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots
