TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees | Topiary on stem: multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement**: none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts**: food forest, Eco planting, Landscape planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, wide oval | Crown structure: dense | Height: 15 - 18 m | Width: 10 - 15 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 8A

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist, wet | Light requirements: sun, partial shade, shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | Extreme environments: no infection with bleeding canker, no infestation by horse-chestnut leaf miner

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, big | Flower colour: yellow-pink | Flowering period: May - May | Leaf colour: blue-green | Leaves: deciduous, ovoid, palmate, big, underside hairy, composite | Autumn colour: yellow-brown | Fruits: striking, toxic, large, capsule, husk | Fruit colour: green | Bark colour: brown, grey | Bark: smooth, later on rough | Twig colour: brown | Twigs: bare | Root system: deep, moderately branched, fleshy roots
