Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees | Topiary on stem: multi-stem umbrella

#### USE

**Location**: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement**: none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts**: Eco planting, Landscape planting, shade-tolerant

### **CHARACTERISTICS**

Crown shape: rounded, wide pyramidal | Crown structure: dense | Height: 15 - 18 m | Width: 10 - 15 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 8A

#### **ASPECTS**

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist, wet | Light requirements: sun, partial shade, shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | Extreme environments: no infection with bleeding canker, no infestation by horse-chestnut leaf miner

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, big | Flower colour: pale yellow | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: buds yellow, dark green, underside yellow-green | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, obovate, palmate, opposite, underside hairy, serrate, composite | Autumn colour: yellow | Fruits: striking, toxic, capsule, husk | Fruit colour: brown | Bark colour: grey | Bark: peeling, furrowed | Twig colour: pale brown | Twigs: hairy | Root system: moderately branched, fleshy roots, tap root, central root
