Tree types: woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover

USE

Location: central reservation, large garden, countryside, windbreak | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: panicle, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** red | **Fruits:** edible, berry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Twig colour:** black, red | **Twigs:** bare
