TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, fruit trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, small mammals, humans

Flowers: corymbose | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, hairy, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red, violet | **Fruits:** edible, berry | **Fruit colour:** black-violet | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
