Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
