USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies

Flowers: catkins, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, matt polished, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, rarely fruits, catkins | **Bark colour:** white, yellow | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** yellow-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, vertical branches | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, highly branched
