Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.6 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 0, pollen value 1

Flowers: catkins | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, deltoid, opposite, dissected, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** white | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels, horizontal branches, pendulous, finely branched, long shoots | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
