Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: panicle | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, leaf thorns, curly | **Fruits:** small, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** thorned
