Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies

Flowers: catkins, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, polished, hairy, dentate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** white, cream | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** hairy, vertical branches | **Root system:** deep
