Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover | **Topiary:** hedge

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees
