USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 0

Flowers: panicle, striking, pendulous, scented | **Flower colour:** pink-violet | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** grey-green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, big, pendant | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Twig colour:** green
