Location: small garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.5 - 0.8 m | **Width:** 0.6 - 0.7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral (6.6 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution
