TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2.5 - 4.5 m | **Width:** 2 - 3.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: papilionaceous, striking, small | **Flower colour:** pink-violet | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, thick, Nitrogen fixing | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red, red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, pod | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare, zigzagging | **Root system:** deep, extensive
