Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** November - November | **Leaf colour:** yellow-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles | **Fruits:** striking, large, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown, red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare
