Location: park, central reservation, large garden, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Landscape planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 10 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans
