TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.6 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: heads, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white, yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside white-grey | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, opposite, slightly hairy | **Autumn colour:** scarlet, red-violet | **Fruits:** small, drupe, raspberry-like | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** violet | **Twigs:** bare, frosty, pendulous | **Root system:** compact, slightly branched, highly branched, fine roots, central root
