Crown structure: open | Height: 3 - 4.5 m | Width: 3 - 4.5 m | Winter hardiness zone: 5A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: very dry, dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade, shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | Extreme environments: tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, striking | Flower colour: white | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: dark green | Leaves: semi-evergreen, lanceolate, polished, underside hairy | Autumn colour: orange-red, red-violet | Fruits: striking, small, berry | Fruit colour: red | Bark colour: brown | Twig colour: dark brown
