TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, windbreak | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
