Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 11B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, small mammals, birds

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: striking, half filled, small | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, narrow, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, small, thornless, berry | **Fruit colour:** yellow-orange | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
