Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, fruit trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2.5 - 4 m | **Width:** 3 - 4.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.0 - 7.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, humans, nectar value 3, pollen value 0 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution
