Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, humans, nectar value 3, pollen value 0 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution
