### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** avenue, park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 18 m | **Width:** 12 - 18 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.5 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, small mammals

**Flowers:** catkins, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-brown | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, lanceolate, narrow, polished, dissected, lacinate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, edible, small, nut, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** polished | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, highly branched
