**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees | **Topiary on stem:** pleached | **Topiary:** column, pyramid

### USE

**Location:** avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Prairie planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** columnar, narrow oval | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

**Flowers:** catkins, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** violet | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds red, dark red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, polished | **Autumn colour:** violet, green | **Fruits:** edible, small, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet
