Tree types: characteristic trees, fruit trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 8A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** humans | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** green | **Flowering period:** June - September | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, palmate, wide, rough, slightly hairy, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, edible | **Fruit colour:** dark violet, green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** roots push up surface
