TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 0, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** brown, violet | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, serrate, pinnate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, rarely fruits, winged, capsules | **Bark colour:** yellow, grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** yellow, grey | **Twigs:** bare
