Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** non-flowering | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, flabellate, laciniate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** yellow, green | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown
