Tree types: half-stem trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 11B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: infundibular, striking | **Flower colour:** violet | **Flowering period:** August - September | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** small, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare
