**Location:** park, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none

**Crown shape:** wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 0

**Flowers:** umbels, striking, big | **Flower colour:** violet | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, big, wide, slightly hairy, underside hairy, dentate | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
