USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 1 - 1.8 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (4.7 - 7.0) | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: spherical, striking | **Flower colour:** pink, blue | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, big | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** green, pale green | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, polished | **Root system:** deep
