Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

Height: 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: panicle, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, slightly hairy, composite | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare
