Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary:** pyramid, cone

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, tiny, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovate, small, thick, leathery, polished, prickly | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown-violet | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown, violet | **Twigs:** bare
