### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** conifers, woodland planting stock | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** food forest

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** March - March | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, prickly | **Fruits:** discrete, cones | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
