Tree types: standard trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** small mammals, humans | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: catkins | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, lacinate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** striking, edible, nut | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** pale grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** pale grey | **Twigs:** bare
