Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** small mammals, humans

Flowers: catkins, pendulous | **Flower colour:** red-brown | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark red, buds red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, edible, nut | **Fruit colour:** brown, red-violet | **Bark colour:** pale grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** pale grey
