TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: conifers | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Solid planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 7 - 10 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** small, cones | **Fruit colour:** grey-blue | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
