TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7B - 10A

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.2 - 7.8) | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, corymbose, striking, standing, singular | **Flower colour:** pink-violet | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, opposite | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, scarlet | **Fruits:** discrete, small, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** cinnamon-brown, grey-brown, pale grey | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, pendulous | **Root system:** shallow, highly branched
