Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** archway

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: papilionaceous, striking, big, scented | **Flower colour:** golden yellow | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, composite, ternate, Nitrogen fixing | **Autumn colour:** green | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, toxic, pod | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** brown, green | **Twig colour:** green
