TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 12 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: spikes, standing | **Flower colour:** red, green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, small, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, violet | **Fruits:** striking, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey
