USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 3 - 6 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: infundibular, striking, singular, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** orange-red | **Flowering period:** July - August | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, leathery | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** violet | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet
