**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, owls, small mammals, humans, nectar value 3, pollen value 3
