Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 4, pollen value 4

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** January - March | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, polished, prickly | **Fruits:** striking, frosty, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Twig colour:** grey-brown, black
