TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 9 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: tulip-shaped, striking, big | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, wide, polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, cones | **Fruit colour:** pink
